Bhutan often referred to as 'Land of the Thunder Dragon' or 'the last Shangri La' on earth, is situated in the lap of Eastern Himalayas between India and the People's Republic of China. Covering an area of 38,394 sq km, the tiny Himalayan Kingdom is one of the most isolated nations in the world. It is in the relatively unexplored pockets of Asia, which allows only a limited number of discerning travelers to preserve its fragile environment and culture in its magical purity.

This country of rolling hills and deep crags exudes immense charm. The mountains are magnificent, the forest is dense, the people are delightful, the air is pure, the architecture inspiring, simple religious beliefs permeate every aspect of life and art is exemplary. #### <u>Day 1: Bagdogra/New Jalpaiguri to</u> <u>Phuentsholing</u>

Travel time: 3:00 to 4:00 hr (170 km). Upon arrival, our representative will welcome you and transfer to

Phuentsholing, the charming border town of Bhutan.

#### Day 3: Thimphu to Punakha with En Route Sightseeing

Visit Punakha Dzong, Dochula Pass, Chimi Lhakhang Monastery, Punakha Suspension Bridge, and Pho Chhu and Mo Chhu Rivers before returning to Thimphu.

#### Day 5: Hike to Tiger's Nest

Hike time: Around 6 to 7 hours, altitude: 3,120 m, 6.4 km. Experience the iconic Tiger's Nest Monastery hike through pine forests with stunning mountain views.

## Day 7: Phuentsholing to Bagdogra / <u>New Jalpaiguri.</u>

Travel time: 3:00 to 4:00 hr (150.8 km). After breakfast, check out and transfer to Bagdogra Airport for your departing flight.

#### **Day 2: Phuentsholing to Thimphu**

<u>Travel time: 3–4 hr (145.6 km).</u> After breakfast, prepare for journey to Thimphu with immigration formalities, scenic drive, and evening exploration of Clock Tower Square.

#### Day 4: Thimphu Sightseeing to Paro

<u>Travel time: 1:30 min, 50 km.</u> Explore Simtokha Dzong, Buddha Point, Trashichhoedzong, Handicrafts Shop, and Simply Bhutan Museum before heading to Paro.

#### <u>Day 6: Paro to Phuentsholing Via</u> <u>Chele La Pass</u>

Travel Time: 5 hours, 142KMS. Drive to Chele La Pass, Bhutan's highest motorable road at 13,000 feet, with views of Mt. Jomolhari before returning to Phuentsholing.

NOTE: Excursion to Chele La Pass is subject to weather and road conditions. In case of unfavorable conditions, the itinerary will be adjusted to include alternative local attractions in Paro before proceeding to Phuentsholing.

### Punakha and Thimphu Highlights

#### Punakha Dzong

A historic fortress at river confluence, showcasing Bhutanese architecture and deep spiritual significance.



#### **Dochula Pass**

Scenic mountain pass with 108 chortens, offering panoramic Himalayan views and historical remembrance.

#### Chimi Lhakhang Monastery

Fertility temple dedicated to Divine Madman, known for blessings and serene countryside walk.

#### Punakha Suspension Bridge

Bhutan's longest suspension bridge, offering scenic views, fluttering prayer flags, and a peaceful crossing experience.

#### Pho Chhu and Mo Chhu Rivers

Sacred rivers merging in Punakha, symbolizing harmony; ideal for rafting and riverside relaxation.

Simtokha Dzong One of Bhutan's oldest fortresses, it now serves as a center for cultural studies and Buddhist teachings.

#### Buddha Point

Home to the giant Buddha Dordenma statue, offering stunning views of Thimphu and a serene environment.



#### Trashichhoedzong

An impressive fortress and monastery that serves as the seat of Bhutan's government and the summer residence of the monk body.

Handicrafts Shop A great place to shop for traditional Bhutanese handicrafts, such as textiles, thangkas, and wooden carvings.



Simply Bhutan Museum

An interactive museum that immerses visitors in Bhutanese culture, offering activities like archery and traditional dance.



- 1. Bring your original voter card or a valid Indian passport. (Passport should have minimum 6-months validity from the date of travel.)
- 2. For Children (under 18): passport or birth certificate (Details Should be written in English, not in regional language)
- 3. Aadhaar Card is not accepted for adults or children. If using a voter ID, it must be the original issued by a government office, not a PVC card printed from an online download.
- 4. Any documents xerox or downloaded, or colour-printed are not valid; only the original documents need to be carried.
